

## Knoxville Moms Waterfall Scavenger Hunt Printable

<u>Obed Wild and Scenic River</u> : [Up to 1.5 hours drive] Go to Wartburg, TN. You can check out more information at the Visitor's Center (208 North Maiden Street in downtown Wartburg) or highway 62 to Ridge Road (Lily Bridge) OR Catoosa Road (Nemo Bridge).

**Paint Creek:** [Up to 1.5 hours drive] From Greeneville, take TN 70 south for 11.2 miles. Turn right on Rollins Chapel Rd. and follow signs to Paint Creek Campground, then turn right onto Forest Road #41 (Paint Creek Road). From Newport, turn left on TN 107, and travel 10.1 miles. Turn right at Rollins Chapel Road and follow signs to Paint Creek Campground.

**Townsend Spot #1:** [45—50 mins drive] Take highway 411 X. Turn left onto James Jarvis Bridge, take a right, and follow along the road until you see the pull off.

**Townsend Spot #2:** [45—50 mins drive] Travel Walland Highway. At intersection near Ellejoy Road, you will see Coulter's Bridge.

**Townsend Spot #3:** [45—50 mins drive] Take highway 411 X. Keep going into the Great Smoky National Park. At the spilt in the road toward Gatlinburg and Cades Cove, you will see a parking area to your left. Park there and you will see plenty of folks!

**Rock Island State Park.** [Up to 2 hours drive] 82 Beach Rd, Rock Island, TN 38581. Follow I-40 W to US127 S/N Main St in Crossville. Take exit 317 from I-40 W. Take exit 317 for US-127 toward Crossville/Jamestown. Turn left onto US-127 S/N Main St (signs for Crossville/Pikeville). Turn right onto Northside Dr. Slight right to stay on Northside Dr. Turn right onto US-70 W. Turn left onto N Butler St. Turn right onto E Maple St. Turn left onto S Young St. Turn right onto Carter Rd. Turn left onto US-70S W. Use the left 2 lanes to take the U.S. 70S W ramp to McMinnville. Continue onto US-70S W. Turn left onto TN-287 S. Turn right onto Beach Rd.

Indian Boundary State Park. [Up to 2 hours drive] From Interstate 75 - take Exit 60, turn south on TN 68 for approximately 30 miles. In Tellico Plains, turn left on TN 165 (Cherohala Skyway) for approximately 17 miles. Turn left onto FR 345. Follow signs in to Indian Boundary Recreation Area.

**Deep Creek.** [Up to 2.5 hours drive] To get to Deep Creek, head to Bryson City, NC and follow the signs three miles to Deep Creek. OR stay at Deep Creek Camping. From US 74 and exit 67, go down the hill (north) on Veterans Blvd. At the first light, turn right on to Main Street (US 19). At the next light, turn left

on to Everett Street (in front of the Courthouse Museum). Immediately after crossing the train tracks at the train depot turn right on to Depot Street. At the stop sign at the end of Depot Street, turn left on to Ramseur, then immediately right on to Deep Creek Road. Go a quarter mile and curve left (do not cross the bridge). You'll find us about a half mile on your right. Registration is in the log cabin general store.

**Hiwassee River.** [Up to 2 hours drive] Take 411 South through Etowah, TN. After you cross the Hiwassee River bridge turn left on TN 30 East. Follow TN 30 east 6 miles past the Texaco Station and the old church/schoolhouse. Our sign and driveway will be on the left. OR Take I-75 South to Athens, Tennessee and take TN 30 East exit. Follow TN 30 East all the way past the Texaco Station and the old church/schoolhouse. Our sign and driveway will be on the left. (Note: from Etowah to intersection at Hiwassee Corner Market, TN 30 East and U.S. 411 South are the same highway.) Gee Creek Campground: 404 Spring Creek Road, Delano, Tennessee 37325

Ocoee River/ Conasauga Blue Hole. [Up to 2.5 hours drive] From Interstate-75 to Cleveland, TN exit #20 (Cleveland by-pass). Take the bypass 6.5 miles to US 64 east (towards Ocoee); follow US 64 8 miles to Hwy 411. Turn right (south) onto 411. Travel 6.7 miles on US 411 and turn left onto TN 313 at the Marathon gas station (Ladd Springs Road which becomes Willis Springs Rd.). Travel 4 miles until the pavement ends, then bear right on gravel Forest Service Road 221 (Pea Vine/Sheeds Creek Rd.). Continue for 4.7 miles as the road climbs and winds until you reach the Conasauga River Trail Head (#61) parking lot. Turn right into the parking area. Travel time from Chattanooga is approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.
